



FREEZE WARNINGS!

It doesn't happen very often, but when it does- here are some tips to protect your water lines:

- 1) Insulate all outside pipes and hose bibs with cloth, or similar material. (drain water from hoses first) Don't forget any exposed pipes in attic spaces where they may freeze
- 2) Ensure that the cover on your Water Meter fits tightly. If your pipes should freeze, you can use valve inside meter box to turn water off. This will avoid many problems when the frozen pipes thaw.
- 3) Protect the Backflow Assembly, if you have one.
- 4) Run at least 1 faucet in your home at a thin stream.
